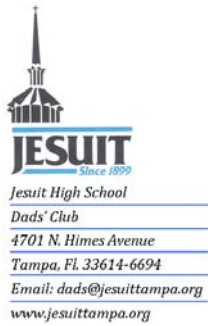

The Dads' Club is a service organization open to all parents of current and former Jesuit students who have a desire to assist and enhance Jesuit High School. The Dads' Club provides volunteers and resources to assist the school in several areas such as athletic event parking attendants, kitchen help for Homecoming and other school social events, and manpower and organizational assistance with school fundraisers. For the 2010/2011 school year the Dads' Club members provided 4,500 volunteer hours to the school. Each year the Dads' Club assists Jesuit's Development Office with the Bucs and USF Parking program, a major annual fundraiser for the school. The primary goal of Dads' Club members is to set positive leadership examples for their sons, and their commitment to service helps support Jesuit's mission to produce graduates who are truly "men for others."

Dads' Club Parking provides a very valuable function for all visitors to the Jesuit Campus for special events such as sporting and other school events. It eliminates a lot of the confusion for everyone visiting our campus and portrays a very welcoming atmosphere.

- *Volunteers for these events are needed at various times prior to each event. A coordinator will provide specific information for each event. Typically 7 to 9 volunteers are need for each event.*

Stadium Event Parking is the Dads' Club only fund-raising event, last year raising \$228,000. Each year we facilitate parking for all Buccaneer and USF home football games, and other stadium events at the Jesuit campus, Sun Trust parking lot, Highwoods lots, and lot next to Buccaneer training facility. All are located just south of the campus on Himes Avenue. Each game requires 20 to 25 volunteers.

- *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up each of the parking lots 4 hours prior to each game. Typically 6 to 8 volunteers are needed for this activity. An additional 14 to 17 volunteers are needed to facilitate parking at all 4 parking lots. Those wanting to attend the game should have no problem getting to the stadium by kick-off. We start to clean up 10 to 15 minutes after each game starts. Drinks are provided during each game and sandwiches at the end of each game.*

Gaudiosa is an annual dinner, dance and auction event. It is a major fund-raiser for Jesuit High School that is hosted by the Mothers' Club.

- *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up, clean up and transport auction items to the event and back to Jesuit High School.*

Homecoming BBQ is a pre-game Homecoming event. Barbecue meals are ordered and served in the Jesuit cafeteria.

- *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up and tear down tables and chairs. Volunteers are also need to serve the barbecue meals. There are always enough dads around to help clean up should your son be playing in the game.*

Fr. Hartnett Memorial Golf Classic is an annual fundraiser sponsored by the Jesuit Alumni Association. This is the longest running golf charity fundraiser in Tampa. *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up and man the event refreshment stations along the course. Volunteers can also sign up to play in the event.*

Celebration of the Arts showcases the fine work of our students' artistic endeavors. The Music Department students will perform, and the Masque Club will provide a short presentation. Artwork created by our students will be on exhibit. Food is typically provided by numerous area restaurants, and the Dads' Club participates by sponsoring a food table that cooks and serves sausage and pepper sandwiches.

- *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up and tear down tables and chairs for the event. Volunteers are also needed to cook and serve the sausages and peppers for the Dads' Club food table.*

Jesuit Olympic Village at the Special Olympics is a great opportunity for fathers and sons to participate in a very worthy community service activity. Dads and sons spend time with these special athletes by helping them to get to their events, attend the medal ceremonies, and making sure they enjoy the food and fun at the Jesuit Olympic Village tent. This is a truly gratifying experience and you and your son will leave with some warm memories.

- *Volunteers (fathers and sons) for this event are needed to help set up and tear down tables, chairs, and games. Help is also needed taking photos for athletes and father/sons. Signing up for this event will not sign you and your son up for escorting athletics during the day, which must be done through a special sign-up at school. Your sons will be notified of that sign-up procedure.*

Men for Others Dinner is for students and their fathers, and/or important men in their lives to join together for a wonderful meal and to enjoy each other's company. There is always a keynote speaker with an important message and a wrap-up of the Dads' Club year.

- *Volunteers for this event are needed to help set up, coordinate the event activities and clean up after the event.*
