



## **Darby, Bradley, and Galvis Lead Tigers over Gainesville!!**

This game was one sided from the opening tip. GHS didn't score until about 3:30 left in the first quarter. The score after the first was 22-3. Our defensive intensity was incredible and we were being very smart on offense, not forcing the issue, only taking what the defense gave us. Zak was a huge deterrent to GHS's offense. Whether we played man or zone, their plan was to drive to the basket, but Zak was there to reject a lot of their shots which stopped them from trying (he easily had 5-6 blocks). We did a great job taking care of the basketball, very few turnovers. Our press and half court trap caused quite a bit of chaos forcing at least 20 turnovers. Brad and Meddich were extremely active in our traps causing GHS to hurry their offense and make poor passes. We gave up very few offensive rebounds, and with their inability to shoot the outside jumper, there was plenty of opportunities. I don't have the stats, but I wouldn't doubt that Zak, Meddich, and maybe Galvis had at least 10 rebounds each with Brad and Cameron grabbing a few them-selves. And between PJ, JJ, and Galvis, they each easily had 3-5 steals each, if not more. The final score was 56-34, but was not that close. We slowed the offense down in the fourth quarter, scoring only 5 points, but with our defense holding them to only 7 in the 4th, we didn't need to score. They were very athletic, aggressive, and physical but once we took the big lead they had a tough time getting anything going on offense to make a run.
