



Tigers Put on an Offensive Display for the Record Books!!

The Jesuit Tigers varsity football team came into Friday night's contest looking to add a win to their district total against the upstart Strawberry Crest Chargers. They did just that and more in amassing over four hundred and fifty total yards and sixty three points. The point total set a single game scoring record for the Tigers in a game that featured a running clock in the fourth quarter. Senior Bobby Eveld completed fourteen of eighteen pass attempts for two hundred and eight yards and four touchdowns, a career-high. The four touchdown passes puts Bobby's season touchdown total amongst the county leaders. Rusty Davis led the ground game for the Tigers with one hundred and twenty one yards on just eight attempts and one touchdown. Robby Garcia added sixty seven yards and two touchdowns in limited action while Miles Bennett had twenty one yards and a touchdown. Junior Patton Chillura came into the second half and continued the onslaught with a touchdown pass to Joe Twomey. The Tiger's defense recorded their third shut-out of the season.
