5. Books are arranged below by grade level and then department which is identified in parentheses. Please check carefully if your son is enrolled in an out-of-sequence course.

Psychology ..... Forty Studies that Changed Psychology

American Foreign Relations ..... American Foreign Policy, all editions but the 2010 edition will no longer be used

**Foreign Language**

Spanish 4 Honors (will not be taught in 2011-2012) ..... all books will be used in AP Spanish Language

For 2011-2012 school year: French 1 workbook must be retained for French 2, Spanish 1 text and workbook must be retained for Spanish 2, Latin 1 H text must be retained for Latin 2 H; French 2 workbook must be retained for French 3, Spanish 2 text and workbook must be retained for Spanish 3 (not needed for Spanish 3 Honors).
