



Ryan Stanley '02 **Jesuit High School JV Head Coach**

Ryan Stanley is entering his third season as Jesuit's Junior Varsity head coach. Ryan Stanley grew up in Tampa having attended Most Holy Redeemer. He graduated from Jesuit High School in 2002. He was a 1st baseman for Coach John Crumbley. Coach Stanley hit .405 with six home runs and earned all-county honors as a junior at Jesuit. He was two-year letter winner for Coach John Crumbly at Jesuit High School as a first baseman and pitcher. He was an all-county selection in 2001 and 2002 and hit .367 with seven home runs in his final two seasons at Jesuit. Coach Stanley was rated among the top 30 high school first baseman by Team One Baseball and was a member of the Team Florida USA summer baseball program that won the USA Baseball Junior Olympics national championship and the CABA World Series. He was named to the all-tournament teams at the CABAWS. Coach Stanley was an honor roll student at Jesuit.

After Jesuit, Coach Stanley spent three years at Georgia Tech on a baseball scholarship. He made the all ACC academic honor roll in 2003-2004 and was a member of two Atlantic Coast Conference Championship teams. In 2005 Coach Stanley transferred to Auburn University and finished out his final two years of baseball eligibility. He earned a degree in Logistics in May of 2007 from Auburn. He currently is the President of Ryanco Logistics Inc., a freight brokerage company in Tampa, FL.
