Jesuit Dress Code Guidelines: Shoes

During the school day (from 7:55 a.m. until dismissal from academic responsibilities) students are to wear dress shoes with leather uppers only. Suede is not permitted. Shoe colors are limited to solid colors, BROWN, LIGHT BROWN or BLACK. Extreme colors such as white, blue, red, green are not permitted. Styles that are athletic or athletic/sneaker-inspired, have an athletic logo, chevrons or stripes are unacceptable. Dress boots that conform to the guidelines above are permitted. Shoes must be laced and in good condition. See examples of acceptable and unacceptable shoes below and on the school website. **Note:** These are guidelines and any questions or concerns should be referred to the Assistant Principal for Discipline.

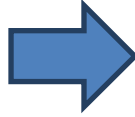

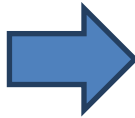

Additional shoe guidelines for deck style shoes.

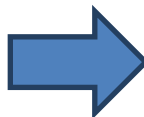
Acceptable: Light Brown, Solid color,
