Dear Parent:

Your son will be attending Jesuit's Homecoming Dance on Saturday, October 9, 2010. It is important that you and your son be aware of Jesuit's dance policies that exist to provide a positive experience for the students on this very special occasion. Please read the policies below with your son and sign and return this Policy Acknowledgement form to the Jesuit Administration. **This form must be received by the Jesuit High School administration at the school's main office no later than Friday, October 8, 3:00 p.m. Students will not be allowed to purchase a dance ticket unless this form is completed and returned.**

- **SUBSTANCE ABUSE:** Students at school-sponsored events are not allowed to be either in possession of or under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance (Student Handbook, page 41).
- **ATTENDANCE:** All students attending the dance must arrive by 9:30 p.m. and remain at the dance until 11:00 p.m. The parents of students not arriving by 9:30 p.m. will be contacted by a Jesuit administrator, informing them that their son has not arrived. Students arriving at the dance after 9:30 p.m. will not be permitted to enter the dance, and the parents will be contacted accordingly (Student Handbook, page 33).
- **PARTY BUSES:** Students arriving to the dance by way of a party bus will *not* be permitted to enter the dance (Student Handbook, page 33).
- **DRESS CODE:** The dress code is semi-formal. Young ladies should not wear any attire that is too low-cut in the front or the back, that is sheer and/or revealing, or that has a bare midriff or cutouts revealing the midriff area. Attire that reveals cleavage or a back below the waistline will not be permitted. For young men, semi-formal means suit, tie, dress shirt, dress slacks, dress shoes, and socks (Student Handbook, page 33).
- **DANCING:** Dance styles such as "grinding", or any other style that does not reflect the values of Jesuit High School will not be permitted. Warnings that remain unheeded may result in the removal of the students involved, parental notification, and, if necessary, disciplinary action (Student Handbook, page 33).
- **EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM:** The attached emergency contact form must be completed and returned to the Jesuit High School Administration along with this signed Policy Acknowledgement form in order for your son to attend the homecoming dance. Emergency information for your son's guest is also required.
- **In case of an emergency a school administrator can be contacted at the dance at 727-403-8380.**

It is our hope that your son has a wonderful time. We feel by making you aware of this information, you will be confident that your son will have a fun and safe homecoming experience.
