

# USF's Lockwood Earns Freshman Honors

TAMPA University of South Florida freshman outfielder **Ryan Lockwood** was named Collegiate Baseball newspaper's Freshman Player of the Year on Wednesday, and Lockwood also was one of three former Jesuit High standouts named to the Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American Team.

Lockwood, an outfielder, was a first team All-Big East selection after hitting .415 with 15 doubles, 37 RBIs and stealing 12 bases. He also had a 30-game hitting streak going before an injury cut short his season.

Lockwood was joined on the All-American team by former Tigers standouts **Stephen Hunt** and **Sam Dyson**. Hunt, also a freshman at USF, made the team as a designated hitter after batting .353 with three homers, seven doubles and 33 RBIs. Dyson, a freshman right-handed pitcher at South Carolina, made the team after going 5-0 with a 4.33 ERA with 26 strikeouts for the Gamecocks.
