Twins to add Jesuit grad to Hall of Fame in 2009

MINNEAPOLIS — George Brophy and **Jesuit alum Brad Radke** are this year's additions to the Minnesota Twins Hall of Fame.

Radke spent his entire 10-year career with the Twins and took the mound on opening day in nine of those seasons. He is second on the club's all-time list with 377 games started, and third with 148 victories and 1,467 strikeouts.

Brophy and **Radke** will bring the team's Hall of Fame roster to 21 people. They'll be honored in a pregame ceremony at the Metrodome on July 11.

- The right hander was drafted by the Twins in the eighth round (pick 206) of the 1991 amateur draft.
- **Radke** made his debut on April 29, 1995 against the Baltimore Orioles in relief of LaTroy Hawkins.
- He was voted to Baseball Digest's 1995 All-Star Team and finished ninth in Rookie of the Year voting.
