Richie Warren is entering his 6th year as Jesuit's head baseball coach with a record of 126-27. Coach Warren grew up in Tampa area having attended grade school at Most Holy Redeemer. He graduated from Jesuit High School in 2000 having lettered in baseball for Coach John Crumbley for three years. Coach Warren was a starting pitcher on the 2000 4A state championship baseball team, having won the state semi-final game 2-1.

After Jesuit, Coach Warren attended the University of Florida where he started his coaching career as an assistant at P.K. Yonge High School at the age of 19. He also coached at Alachua Santa Fe High School for 2 years before returning back to Jesuit in August of 2004 as a Social Studies teacher and assistant baseball coach to John Crumbley. Coach Warren was named Head Coach of Jesuit on September 7, 2006. He was named district 4A-9 coach of in 2007, 2010, and 2011. He was also named district 5A-10 coach of the year in 2009. Coach Warren was named Coach of the Year by the Tampa Tribune in 2011.

Coach Warren has been married for 6 years to his wife Alyson. They have one child, Mason.
